

# PROPHECIES CONCERNING YAHSHUA AS THE MESSIAH

This study is very important to true believers who want to worship in spirit and truth. (John 4:24) Many of us already believe that Yahshua, the Son of Yahweh, is the true savior who should come and pay for our sins and iniquities. But, some do not believe in Him. Even the brethren that do follow Him may not know very much about the extensive number of prophecies in the Old Testament concerning His ministry, death and resurrection. As His followers, we need to know the proofs of calling for ourselves and those we witness to. Yes, we are His witnesses. Blessed are those who have not seen and yet believe. (John 20:29) We will present the main prophecies already recorded plus the fulfillment of those in the New Testament. We will also include other statements and facts that appear in the New Testament verifying His office, authority and victory.

We also hope that Christians, who are mostly of the tribes of Israel, will take notice of other truth in this presentation. The true names of the Father and the Son, Yahweh and Yahshua. Though they use the same bible we do, the King James version has so many changes from the original manuscripts. (The name of the savior) The names of Yahweh and Yahshua are imperative to the first fruits salvation calling. (Rev 22:4)

We have other important brothers that right now do not believe Yahshua came. These are our Jewish brothers who were told a lie about His resurrection. The scripture reports that the Pharisees had two soldiers lie and say that the disciples came and stole the body of Yahshua. This lie was spread by the Pharisees so people would not believe the miracle that He was raised from the dead. (Matt 28:14-15) Many Jewish people believe that report today in spite of the fact that over five hundred people saw Yahshua after his passion. It is possible that this study may be witness to some of the truth of Yahshua's work on the stake. We do know that all will come into the knowledge of His atonement and that every knee will bow to Him. Right now, due to the removal of the ceremonial law of the Old Testament (Temple worship, animal sacrifice, Levitical Priesthood), the Jewish people have no payment or covering for their sins. The book of Hebrews makes it clear that the blood of bulls and goats can not pay for sin. (Heb 10:4)

Yahshua is the only payment and offering that does atone for us. And it is Father Yahweh's will that all men come to the knowledge of this truth. All the tribes, some day, will be united again under Yahshua. He is Savoir, King, Husband, Master and Elohim of Israel!

We here present the main thirty eight prophecies of the Tanakh for your review. When Yahshua appeared to the two Apostles after His resurrection and He opened the scriptures to them, these were the verses He quoted (Luke 24:32)How wonderful His offering was. He was the lamb without spot or wrinkle. (John 1:29)

### OTHER WITNESSES OF HIS OFFICE

Besides the fulfilled prophecies we have reviewed, there are other powerful witnesses in the New Testament of His divine nature as the Son, creator and the Law giver. ( John 1:1-4; John 5:46) In His three and one half year ministry, He did thousands of miracles of healing that verified that He came not just to bless but also give life. (John 1:4) He is the light of men and that life was shared with all that would come to Him and believe. All that touched Him were healed. (Matt 14:36) Life in Him is more than health or blessing. It is life eternal in the family of Yahweh and New Jerusalem. (Rev 21:2)

Yahshua also verified His qualifications as the perfect lamb by the set-a -part life that He led. He has no sin, or ever fell short of the law of sin. (1 John 3:4) (Heb 4:15)

Yahshua, being perfect and could not lie, said that He was the Savior of the world. Can we accept His testimony? ( Matt 27:43)( Matt 16:16-17) The Apostles saw Him and believed (1 John 4:14) Even the centurion believed He was the Son of Yahweh ( Matt 27:54) He raised people from the dead. He walked on water. He showed His divine glory to Peter, James and John. (Matt 17:2-3) And the voice came of the Father: "THIS IS MY BELOVED SON IN WHOM I AM WELL PLEASED" His entire life was a miracle of divine power, love and righteousness.

Here is the thing: He is called Master: 200 times\*\* He is our Master. Most believers are taught that Father Yahweh is our headship and Sovereign. That is absolutely not scriptural or the Father's will. Even



though He is above all, He placed Yahshua over us as King, Savior, headship, Husband and Master. (Ps. 110:1) When we are baptized into His Name and resurrection, we become betrothed to Him. He becomes our Husband, we are the bride. This is the Father's will. Yahshua is the one who bought us, and paid for us. He is the one who is coming for us, not the Father. He is also our healer, the Great Physician. (James 5: 13-15). Seeking the Father for everything and putting Yahshua in the background, will stunt your spiritual growth and frustrate the Father and Yahshua. This is why He told the Apostles: "FOLLOW ME". (John 17:9; John 17:12; John 13:13; Matt 16:24). He is also the one who spoke to the prophets and the Revelator who gave the end time prophecies to John. One can not love Him, and at the same time, ignore Him!

He is called King: 70 times  
He is called Husband: 30 times  
He is called Deliverer: 2 times  
He is called creator: 1 time  
He is called The Way: 1 time  
The Son of Yahweh: 50 times

Are there tears in your eyes? Are you down on your knees? There are two things that have to happen when you have read this article. One: you believe the witness and testimonies. Second, you have the revelation of His love for you. Yes, He is the love gift the Father sacrificed to bless, and save us.

**John 1:12** But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of Yahweh, *even* to them that believe on his name:

Yahshua suffered and died for each one of us individually. While He was on the stake, He knew each one of us. While we were yet sinners, Yahshua died for us. (Rom 5:8) The Father first loved us and gave us His son. (John 3:16; 1 John 4:10) That is the Good News! That is the Evangel! The parable of the seed tells us much about truth and Yahshua.

**John 12:24** Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a grain of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit.

We must have a revelation of the power of His love within each one of us. It has to break our hearts. That broken heart leads to repentance. That pain leads us to a personal love relationship with Him. Unless we have the spiritual power and revelation, we will not keep the truth. We will not hold to the truth. It will mean nothing. The parable of the sower:

**Mat 13:20-21** But he that received the seed into stony places, the same is he that heareth the word, and immediately with joy receiveth it;

Yet hath he not root in himself, but endureth but for a season: for when tribulation or persecution ariseth because of the word, by and by he is offended.

**Mat 11:27** All things are delivered unto me of my Father: and no man knoweth the Son, but the Father; neither knoweth any man the Father, save the Son, and *he* to whomsoever the Son will reveal *him*.

No man comes unto me unless the father draws him. No man comes unto the father except by me. ( John 6:44 )

**John 6:43-46** Yahshua therefore answered and said unto them, Murmur not among yourselves. No

man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day. It is written in the prophets, And they shall be all taught of Yahweh. Every man therefore that hath heard, and hath learned of the Father, cometh unto me. Not that any man hath seen the Father, save he which is of Elohim, he hath seen the Father.

We have to literally fall in love with Him. He says: if you love me...follow me...We have to put Him first before everything else. He has to become everything to us in this life.

**Mat 10:37-40** He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me. And he that taketh not his stake, and followeth after me, is not worthy of me. He that findeth his life shall lose it: and he that loseth his life for my sake shall find it. He that receiveth you receiveth me, and he that receiveth me receiveth him that sent me.

If you have received this truth in power, it maybe that you are called and embraced by the Father to be one of His first born in the Kingdom. We have to love the truth; we have to love the word; We have to love Yahshua before ourselves and others.

**John 11:25** Yahshua said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this?

That is what Yahshua wants to know today. Do you believe him? Will you love Him? Will you obey Him? How can we believe in Him and not believe the whole truth of the word?

We live in a very dark age just before He will return. His truth is going out all over the world. It will be a short time till the two witnesses come and help evangelize the world. But, today, the truth is being evil spoken of and perverted. We can not mix truth and error, especially when we are speaking about Kodesh things. Read this scripture:

**1 John 1:4-7** And these things write we unto you, that your joy may be full. This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that Elohim is light, and in him is no darkness at all. If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness; we lie and do not the truth: But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Yahshua the Messiah his Son-cleanseth us from all sin.

## THERE IS A LIST OF BELIEFS THAT ARE AGAINST HIM...SOME PEOPLE FOLLOW

There is a whole list of Anti-Messiah doctrines that some people believe and spread about. They defile them as sin. It separates them from Yahshua. It displeases the Father and takes away protection and blessings. At some point, it takes people out of the calling all together. Read this list and see what Satan says about Yahshua.
